Main Duties & Responsibilities

As Future Fifty Programme Manager, you are responsible for:

- Running an exciting and relevant Events Programme:
 - Running a portfolio of events including breakfast meet-ups, mid-day roundtables & dinner and drinks socials
- Data management, CRM and reporting:
 - Managing the CRM system and keeping it up to date.
 - Clear and continuous reporting on measures of success
 - Applying trend analysis and drawing conclusions from data collated. Iterate to optimise events formats using quantitative and qualitative data analysis.
- Community Management:
 - Maintain speedy and concise communication with the companies, and key stakeholders
 - Run online email groups e.g Slack Channels for maximum engagement
 - Development of online tools to support community engagement
- Networking:
 - Network to continually source experts who can add to the Future Fifty programme and be a great advocate for the programme.
- Marketing Content and social media:
 - Producing marketing content, managing the Future Fifty blog working closely with Tech City UK marketing team.
 - Developing social media content for the programme
- Collaboration with the wider Tech City UK team



- Knowing how to leverage the wider team to achieve shared objectives and supporting the team on wider Tech City UK initiatives
